Fortnightly recycling: (Rubbish is collected weekly).

Public holidays: There are three public holidays when waste collection services are delayed: Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Good Friday.

New collection day: Rubbish and recycling collections following a public holiday are collected one day later.

What to put in:

- Plastic bottles and containers from the kitchen, bathroom and laundry with any of these symbols marked on the base or side of the container:



Take the lids off, rinse container and squash.

- Glass bottles and jars (please rinse)
- Aluminium, steel and tin cans (rinse and squash) and empty aerosol cans.



What not to put in:

- Plastic shopping bags and cling film
- Polystyrene packaging (meat trays, takeaway coffee cups)
- Refill packs
- Disposable nappies
- Light bulbs
- Garden waste
- Rubbish or food waste
- Hot ashes
- Mirrors
- Windscreen or window glass.

Your recycling bin and paper and cardboard are collected every fortnight on the same day as your rubbish collection. Place your recycling bin, and tied paper and cardboard out the night before your collection or before 7.30am on the day of your collection.

Do not overfill your bin

The lid must be closed for collection – and do not place extra items on top of the bin as these cannot be collected.

Rubbish collection

The council provides a weekly rubbish collection for households using prepaid rubbish bags. To check your area's rubbish collection day call Actionline or visit the council's website.

Public holidays

If your rubbish and recycling collection falls on Christmas Day, New Year's Day and Good Friday, it will be collected the following day. On all other public holidays, please observe your regular collection day.
