

## Notice of Final Decisions to Assign or Alter or Remove Place Names

Pursuant to section 15 of the New Zealand Geographic Board Act 1946, notice is hereby given of the final decisions of the New Zealand Geographic Board Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aotearoa to assign new or alter existing or remove existing place names, stated in the first column of the Schedule below, to the places described in the second column of the said Schedule, and that such decisions take effect on 15 May 2008.

### Schedule

#### *North Auckland Land District*

Waimangō Point	Coastal point on the north-western shores of the Firth of Thames, topographic map 260-S11 Waiheke, GR 136 656. Spelling alteration from Waimangu Point.
Waimangō Stream	Stream flowing generally north-easterly into the Firth of Thames at Waimangō Point, topographic map 260-S11 Waiheke, source: GR 100 612, confluence: GR 135 656. Spelling alteration from Waimangu Stream.

Pinehill	Existing. Topographic map 260-R10 Whangaparaoa, centred around NZMG coordinate 2664330E, 6495300N.
Rosedale	Existing. Topographic map 260-R10 Whangaparaoa, centred around NZMG coordinate 2663500E, 6493680N.

#### *Nelson Land District*

Lake Daniell	Lake, north-east of Springs Junction, topographic map 260-M31 Lewis, GR 515 785. Spelling alteration from Lake Daniells.

#### *Canterbury Land District*

Emerald Stream	Stream flowing generally east-south-easterly towards Tengawai River, crossing SH 8 immediately north of the Hunterslea Road intersection at GR 401 626 (Bridge No. 3), north of Albury, topographic map 260-J38 Geraldine, source: GR 358 641. Not named on current map.
Kaitiaki Peak	Peak at height 2222m, located in the Mount Cook Range above Ball Pass, topographic map 260-H36 Aoraki/Mount Cook, GR 804 252. Not named on current map.
Pulpit Rock	Isolated and prominent rock formation, 3km west of the locality of French Farm at the north-west inner reaches of Akaroa Harbour, topographic map 260-N36&N37 Akaroa, GR 997 132. Not named on current map.
Rocky Gully River	River flowing generally north-easterly into the Tengawai River, near Albury, topographic maps 260-J38 Geraldine, 260-J39&K39 Timaru, and 260-I39 Kirkliston, source from the Hunters Hills on 260-I39: GR 296 453, confluence on 260-J38: GR 417 609. River not named on current map. Gorge currently named Rocky Gully.

#### *Westland Land District*

Gibb Creek	Stream flowing generally north-westerly along the Omoeroa Range, and into Omoeroa River, topographic map 260-G35,H35&H34 Franz Josef/Waiau, source: GR 756 549, confluence: GR 706 603. Spelling alteration from Gibbs Creek.
Lake Gibb	Small lake, north-west of Lake Mueller and 5–6km north of the locality of Fox Glacier, topographic map 260-G35,H35&H34 Franz Josef/Waiau, GR 683 506. Spelling alteration from Lake Gibbs.
Matthies Creek	Stream flowing generally northerly from Bald Hill, and into Whakapohai River (Little River), west of Lake Moeraki, topographic maps 260-F36&G36 Paringa, and 260-F37 Haast, source on 260-F37: GR 056 076, confluence on 260-F36 & G36: GR 081 125. Spelling alteration from Mathias Creek.

#### *Westland/Otago Land Districts*

Mount Clark	Mountain at height 2450m, located on the Southern Alps/Kā Tiritiri o te Moana, between the Landsborough and Hopkins Rivers, topographic map 260-H37 Tasman, GR 558 011. Spelling alteration from Mount Clarke.

#### *New Zealand Undersea Feature Names to be Removed*

Norman Rocks	47°43.17'S Latitude, 178°57.10'E Longitude. Formerly underwater rocks, 6.5km north-west of the Bounty Islands. Recorded as Norman Rocks on earlier charts but the feature no longer exists. Hydrographic Chart NZ 3111. Norman Rocks removed from the latest chart.
Rosario Rock	47°48.96'S Latitude, 178°58.50'E Longitude. Formerly underwater rock, 7.5km south-west of the Bounty Islands. Recorded as Rosario Rock on earlier charts but the feature no longer exists. Hydrographic Chart NZ 3111. Rosario Rock removed from the latest chart.
